Class Schedule and Eligibility Information

About the Program

This program is professionally managed by ABC-VA and utilizes the NCCER Content curriculum. The curriculum is nationally recognized, standardized and portable, and incorporates both formal classroom instruction and hands-on training. In addition, instructors are required to complete a formal certification, in order to ensure uniform and consistent delivery of the curriculum.

The ABC-VA Glazier Apprenticeship Program is governed by an Advisory Committee representing the participating contractors. The committee will work with ABC-VA to oversee all aspects of the program.

Term of Apprenticeship

The term of apprenticeship consists of three years or 6,000 hours (approximately 2,000 hours per year) of on-the-job training, and three years or 600 hours (approximately 150 hours per year) of related classroom instruction.

Prerequisites

All rising Level 1 students will be required to take a math assessment test on July 21, 2010 at 1:00 PM at the ABC-VA Training Facility. Students without a passing grade will be required to attend a mandatory math tutoring course August 23-26 from 5-8 PM. Price will be determined by the number of students enrolled.

Class Schedule

Classes and labs will be held at the Hampton Roads ABC-VA Training Facility, 5505 Robin Hood Road, Suite D, Norfolk, Virginia.

Level 1:

- Mondays from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM, beginning August 30, 2010.

Levels 3:

- Wednesdays from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM, beginning Sept. 1, 2010.

Cost

Tuition for the program is \$975 per apprentice, per year for ABC members and \$1275 for non-members. The cost includes textbooks, lab, and administrative fees. **Tuition must be paid in full at the time of registration. No student will be allowed to begin school until tuition has been paid in full.**

Textbooks

Curriculum used is created by the National Center for Construction Education and Research. Textbooks are included in the cost of tuition and will be distributed on the first night of class.

Late Fees & Deadlines

Enroll by **August 6, 2010** to avoid late fees of \$20 per apprentice. No one will be enrolled after September 16, 2010. There will be **NO** refunds after September 16, 2010.

Eligibility

Apprentices must be at least 16 years of age, be employed in the electrical field, have an 8th grade education, and be physically able to perform the work of the glazing trade.

Credit for Prior Knowledge/Experience

A trainee with prior formal classroom education or extensive on-the-job training experience may be eligible for credit. Such individuals must call the ABC-VA office prior to **July 30** in order to determine their eligibility for credit. All other new trainees to the ABC-VA school must register as first-year trainees.

Registration for Apprenticeship Training

All apprentices that wish to enroll for the 2010-2011 session must register by completing the attached registration form and returning it, along with all applicable fees, to the ABC-VA office no later than **August 6, 2010**. Applicable fees must be paid in full before apprentices will be enrolled in class.

Department of Labor Registration

Each participating employer in this program must register all apprentices with the Virginia Department of Labor prior to the start of the school year. For more information, call Louise Griggs at (757) 455-0891, ext. 145.

Grade and Attendance Reports

Grade and attendance reports will be provided to employers/sponsors on a quarterly basis. Employers may request interim reports at any time.

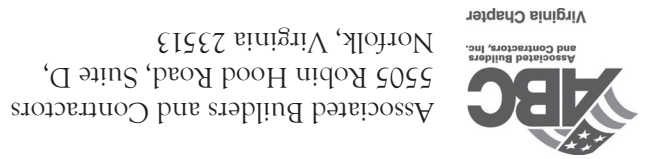
