Class Schedule and Eligibility Information

Term of Apprenticeship

The term of apprenticeship consists of four years or 8,000 hours (approximately 2,000 hours per year) of on-the-job training, and four years or 600 hours (approximately 150 hours per year) of related classroom instruction.

Class Schedule

All classes and labs are held at the ABC training facility in Dulles.

Level One:

- Mondays from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM beginning Sept. 13.
- * All Level 1 students must complete OSHA 10 Hour Certification on Saturday, December 4 from 7:00 AM-5:00 PM.
- * A math test will be given to all Level 1 students on the first day of class. Those who fail must attend a mandatory 8 week math course beginning Wednesday, September 29 from 5:00 to 8:00 PM. There is no additional cost for this class.

Level Two:

- Tuesdays from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM beginning Sept. 14.

Level Three:

- Thursdays from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM, beginning Sept. 16.

Level Four:

- Wednesdays from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM, beginning Sept. 15.
- * All Level 4 students must complete OSHA 30 Hour Certification on Saturdays: January 8, February 12 and March 12 from 7:00 AM-5:00 PM.

Eligibility

Apprentices must be employed in the electrical field, physically able to perform the work of the electrical trade, able to read and write in English, and have a high school diploma or GED.

Level 1 and Level 2 Skip Test

Any apprentice wishing to test out of Level 1 must contact the ABC-VA office. Tests will be given by appointment only and must be taken prior to August 6. The cost for the Level 1 or Level 2 Skip Test is \$100 and is non-refundable.

Registration for Apprenticeship Training

All apprentices that wish to enroll for the 2010-2011 session must register by completing the attached registration form and returning it, along with all applicable fees, to the ABC-VA office no later than **Aug. 13**. Applicable fees must be paid in full before apprentices will be enrolled in class.

Department of Labor Registration

Each participating employer in this program is responsible for registering their apprentices with the Virginia Department of Labor. The company will assume responsibility as the apprenticeship sponsor. Please call the Virginia Department of Labor, (703) 392-0900 ext. 102 or 131.

Cost, Late Fees, Deadlines and Refunds

Tuition for the program is \$950 per apprentice, per year and \$1,200 for non-member students. The cost includes textbooks, lab, and all administrative fees. Tuition must be paid in full at the time of registration.

Any registrations received after Aug. 13 are subject to a late fee of \$20 per apprentice. No registrations will be accepted after September 8. No refunds after second class.

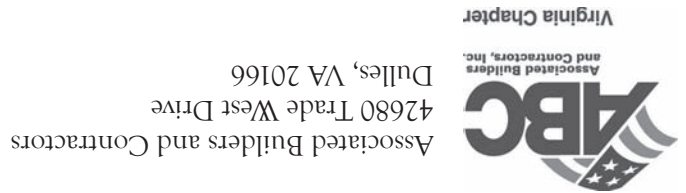
