ABC of Metro Washington & ABC Virginia Honor Merit Shop Contractors During Socially Distanced Excellence in Construction Awards Event

Tysons Corner, VA – The [Metro Washington](#) and [Virginia](#) Chapters of Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) honored the winners of the 39th annual Excellence in Construction Awards, October 29th, during a socially distanced event at the Ritz Carlton in Tysons Corner, VA. The annual Excellence in Construction Awards recognizes and celebrates outstanding projects built by Washington-area ABC members. The awards competition serves to raise the level of construction standards throughout the industry by recognizing the workmanship of those who contribute and by showcasing the results of their dedication.

ABC contractors entered more than 130 projects in categories including architectural ironwork, concrete, stone/tile/flooring, heavy/industrial/transportation, historic restoration, industrial, institutional, interiors, finishes, landscaping, masonry, mechanical, medical renovation, mega

project, mixed use, residential, restaurant interior build-out, retail, specialty and thermal and moisture protection.

"These winning projects highlight and honor the extraordinary teamwork between general contractors, architects and engineers, specialty contractors, and material suppliers," said Patrick J. Dean, president, ABC Virginia Chapter.

A large panel of industry experts served as the competition's judges. This year's panel included industry professionals from a cross-section of the building industry, including architects, owners, government officials, and other industry leaders around the Washington metro-area.

"To select the award winners, more than 100 judges reviewed the entry submittals and visited each project site," said Debbie Livingston, president, ABC of Metro Washington. "Projects were judged on complexity, unique challenges overcome, completion time, workmanship, innovation, cost and safety."

The evening also honored members of the construction team with the presentation of 15 Subcontractor of the Year Awards, voted for by ABC general contractor members.

Subcontractor of the Year Awards were presented in the following categories: concrete; aluminum, glass and glazing; drywall; electrical; finish carpentry and architectural millwork; fire protection; furnishings; landscaping; masonry; mechanical and plumbing; metals; paintings and wall coverings; site work; stone, tile, flooring and carpet; and thermal and moisture protection.
