In 2017, the ABC-VA Excellence in Construction Committee deemed a new award, the "Allegiance Award of Excellence", which serves to recognize a contractor who utilizes the most ABC member subcontractors on a project. ABC Virginia selected W.M. Jordan Company and 16 subcontractors as the winners of the 2018 Allegiance Award of Excellence for the Restoration of the [Historic](#)

[Cavalier Hotel](#) project. This project was also chosen as the overall winner of the 2018 Excellence in Construction Awards.
