A. FINISH

Finish is even, smooth and uniform

No visible seams

All surfaces should be well sanded, pointed up, caulked, smooth and free of cracks and imperfections.

B. WALLS AND CEILING

Walls should be plumb and true to plane.

Wall and ceiling surface is a smooth continuous plan with no visible joints or nail heads

Bulkhead lines are straight and level

Top beads are crisp and flush with ceiling

C. JOINTS

All joints shall be uniform with adjacent surfaces.

No joint-compound build up on window sill, mullions or door jambs.

Outside and inside corners are straight with no evidence of joint build-up
