### WHY INVEST IN APPRENTICESHIP?

It is no secret that our industry faces a shortage of skilled workers on the horizon. Companies that invest in employee development through apprenticeship programs attract a quality workforce of loyal and highly-skilled employees.

### CHOOSE ABC-VA APPRENTICESHIP

ABC-VA has a long history of providing high quality, student-centered learning with an emphasis on hands-on training. Our goal is to give individuals the opportunity to learn a trade, become skilled crafts professionals, earn a good living, and build Virginia. Through our educational affiliate, National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER), we use Contren, a competency-based, task-driven, and nationally recognized curriculum. ABC-VA instructors are required to complete a formal certification in order to ensure consistent delivery of the curriculum. ABC-VA Electrical Contractors Council represents the participating employers and works with ABC-VA staff to oversee the program. This council has shown an unwavering commitment to making certain the program is on the cutting edge, meeting today's workplace needs.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR APPRENTICESHIP

Apprentices must be at least 18 years of age, employed in the electrical field, physically able to perform the work for the electrical trade, **able to read and write in English**, and have a high school diploma or GED equivalent. Participating in the ABC-VA Electrical Contractors Program will be strictly limited to apprentices that are employed by companies that are duly licensed as electrical contractors in Virginia.

### RELATED TRAINING

By providing employers with the Advisory Apprenticeship Program Standards, ABC-VA delivers the related classroom training component of apprenticeship.

### DEPARTMENT OF LABOR REGISTRATION

Employers must register as apprenticeship program sponsors, and must register their apprentices on an individual basis with the Virginia Department of Labor and Industry (DOL) at (804) 371-2327. Without this DOL registration, a student is not considered an apprentice in the state of Virginia.

### 2020 - 2021 TUITION

Tuition is due at time of enrollment. Apprentices employed by ABC-VA members receive a discount. Tuition includes textbooks, lab materials, and administrative fees. Tuition must be paid in full before apprentices will be enrolled.

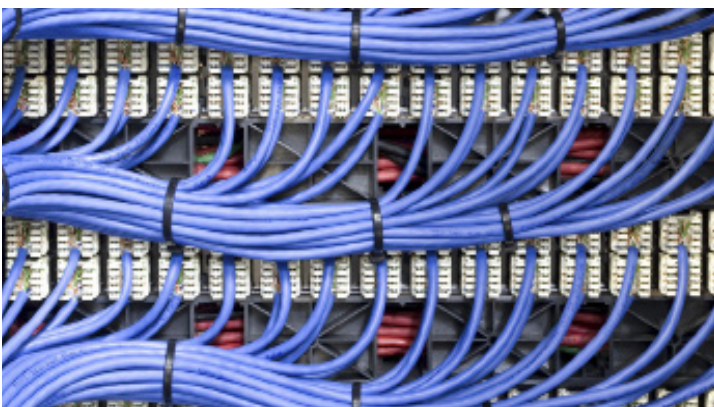

## 2020 - 2021 APPRENTICESHIP SCHEDULE

*The term of apprenticeship consists of four years or 8,000 hours (approximately 2,000 hours per year) of on-the-job training, and four years or 600 hours (approximately 150 hours per year) of related classroom instruction. OJT is administered by the student's employer. Related classroom instruction is administered by ABC-VA.*

**Level 1** will meet every other Tuesday of each month, starting September 1, 2020.

**Level 2** will meet every other Wednesday of each month starting September 2, 2020.

**Level 3** will meet every other Thursday of each month, starting September 3, 2020.

**Level 4** will meet every other Friday of each month, starting September 4, 2020.

Hand Bending, Raceways & Fittings. Conductors and Cables. Basic Electrical Construction Drawings. Residential Electrical Services. Electrical Test Equipment. First Aid, CPR and AED training.

### LEVEL TWO

Alternating Current. Motors. Theory and Application. Electric Lighting. Conduit Bending. Pull and Junction Boxes. Conductor Installations. Cable Tray. Conductor Terminations and Splices. Grounding and Bonding. Circuit Breakers and Fuses. Control Systems and Fundamental Concepts.

### LEVEL THREE

Load Calculations-Branch and Feeder Circuits. Conductor Selection and Calculations. Practical Applications and Lighting. Hazardous Locations. Overcurrent Protection. Distribution Equipment Transformers. Commercial Electrical Services. Motor Calculations. Voice, Data, and Video. Motor Controls. First Aid, CPR and AED training.

### LEVEL FOUR

The primary purpose of the fourth year class is to provide apprentices with comprehensive instruction on the practical application of the National Electric Code.
